ABSTRACTS

Those wishing to present a contribution(s) should upload an Abstract(s) electronically to "RREPS-25" indico webpage until June 30, 2025.

Guidelines: one page Latex 2e or Microsoft Word, Times New Roman 14 pt., the title centered at the top of the page (bold type), one empty line, authors' names (centered), affiliation and complete address (centered), one empty line, text of abstract. The name of the person presenting the contribution should be underlined and supplied by email address (in footnote). Margins of 2.5 cm should be applied. Tables and black and white figures or drawings are possible, if unavoidable. Final version in the Book of Abstracts will be reduced to A5 format. The Program Committee will decide about the acceptance of contributions by August 1, 2025. The authors will be informed about acceptance (oral or poster) of their contributions after August 1, 2025. The information concerning a poster format will be available on the symposium website.

PROCEEDINGS

The Materials of "RREPS-25" symposium will be published as a topical issue of the peer-reviewed European Physical Journal D (EPJD). The Materials should be submitted for publication a month after the conference directly to the journal. Instruction on the submission procedure with the open date and the deadline will be distributed shortly after the symposium and will be available on "http://rreps.tpu.ru" website. The papers are scheduled to be published in the beginning of 2026.

Here are the instructions to get a valid visa for your reference.

I. Know which category of Chinese visa you need.

In general, a **Tourist Visa** (L Visa) will suffice for you to attend the seminar. You do not need to show the letter of invitation from the seminar organizer provided you apply for Tourist Visa. However, if it is required that a **Business Visa** (F Visa) is a must, you probably need an **Invitation Letter**.

II. Submitting visa application materials at your local Chinese consulate or embassy

Please note that different countries or cities may require different visa application materials. Please visit the website of the local Chinese consulate or embassy to check exactly which materials are necessary before making your application.

You must allow adequate time (at least 1.5 months) for the whole visa application process.

Please note that it is your responsibility to obtain an appropriate visa on time.

Tips: local organizers could NOT provide invitation letter to accompanying person according to related regulations. We suggest that accompanying person apply for tourism type visa (when it is available), which will be much easier and require less paperwork.

Note:

- 1. Please submit your files just one time. Multiple submissions may result in invalidation.
- 2. You should guarantee that all information provided is true and correct.
- 3. Due to the large expected number of inquiries, we can only reply to invitation letter queries AFTER you have paid your registration fee.
